

Job Title: Music Director

Part Time Position

Summary:

To lead people of all ages in the congregation in music-making experiences so that they:

- May grow in understanding the Christian faith and the role music plays in that faith
- Will develop and strengthen their relationship with God
- Will become better equipped for daily living as faithful Christian disciples
- Will gain basic music skills so they may effectively participate in musical praise and worship activities

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for all musical activities of the church:
 - Choirs:
 - Chancel Choir
 - Handbell Choir
 - Starting new choirs as needed
 - Special Functions
 - Be director of all of the above choirs or obtain someone to assume the directorship as needed.
 - Direct the congregation in singing under the direction of the Pastor.
- Attend weekly staff meeting with Pastor and Ministry Staff and attend monthly scheduled church council meetings.
- Coordinate the planning and implementation of a comprehensive music ministry for the congregation and community to include traditional sacred music and contemporary music as appropriate.
- Continually learn both about music and about the people in the congregation and community so music can be planned appropriate to their needs.
- Keep the congregation informed about the music needs of people, the goals of the music program, and the resources available that will help the congregation reach these goals.
- Promote the spiritual life of the congregation and its members through music ministry.
- Be responsible for guiding the work of the music program through the year; coordinate and work with the music committee as appropriate and as needed.
- Assist in the selection of hymns for the worship service, under the direction of the Pastor.
- Develop and support effective musical leadership in the church, with the help of the worship chair or team leader.
